

Pursuant to Article 8 item 1), Article 23 paragraph 1 and Article 59 paragraph 2 of the Law on Electronic Communications, (*Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia*, no. 44/10), Article 12, paragraph 1, item 1) and Article 16, paragraph 1 item 4 of the Statute of the Republic Agency for Electronic Communications (*Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia*, no. 59/10), and in accordance with Commission Recommendation of 17 December 2007 on relevant product and service markets within the electronic communications sector susceptible to *ex-ante* regulation in accordance with Directive 2002/21/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on a common regulatory framework for electronic communications networks and services, C (2007) 5046, 2007/879/EC, the

Managing Board of the Republic Agency for Electronic Communications, in its session held on 7 July 2011, adopted the

DECISION
on designating relevant markets susceptible to ex-ante regulation

1. This Decision shall designate relevant markets susceptible to ex-ante regulation in the Republic of Serbia and their geographic dimension.
2. Markets susceptible to ex-ante regulation in the Republic of Serbia shall be the following:
 - 1) Retail access to the public telephone network at a fixed location;
 - 2) Wholesale call origination on the public telephone network at a fixed location;
 - 3) Wholesale call termination on the public telephone network;
 - 4) Wholesale (physical) access to network elements and associated facilities (including shared and full unbounded access to the local loop);
 - 5) Wholesale broadband access;
 - 6) Wholesale leased lines;
 - 7) Wholesale call termination on the mobile network;
 - 8) Retail media contents distribution, and
 - 9) Retail publicly available telephone service at a fixed location.
3. The geographic dimension of the market referred to in item 2 herein shall be the territory of the Republic of Serbia.
4. This Decision shall enter into force on the eight day following its publication in the *Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia*.
