

Pursuant to Article 29, paragraph 3 of the Law on Electronic Communications ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 35/23), in connection with Article 17 of the Law on the Budget System ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", Nos. 54/09, 73/10, 101/10, 101/11, 93/12, 62/13, 63/13 – correction, 108/13, 142/14, 68/15 – other law, 103/15, 99/16, 113/17, 95/18, 31/19, 72/19, 149/20, 118/21, 118/21 – other law, 138/22 and 92/23) and Articles 2, 4 and 6 of the Rulebook on the methodology and manner of determining the costs of providing public services ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", Nos. 14/13, 25/13 – correction and 99/13),

The Council of the Regulatory Authority for Electronic Communications and Postal Services, at its 40th session of the fourth convocation held on August 29, 2024, adopts this

## Rulebook on the amount and method of payment of fees for the provision of services within the competence of the Regulatory Authority for Electronic Communications and Postal Services

"Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", Nos. 92 of November 22, 2024, 95 of November 29, 2024, 77 of September 5, 2025 – other regulations.

*PUBLISHER'S NOTE: The Rulebook on the Harmonization of Fees for the Provision of Services within the Competence of the Regulatory Authority for Electronic Communications and Postal Services ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 77/2025), which entered into force on the eighth day from the date of its publication in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", i.e. September 13, 2025, and shall apply from January 1, 2026, harmonizes the fees prescribed by the Rulebook on the Amount and Method of Payment of Fees for the Provision of Services within the Competence of the Regulatory Authority for Electronic Communications and Postal Services in the manner prescribed by Article 7 of the Rulebook on the Methodology and Method of Determining the Costs of Public Service Provision.*

The text of the Rulebook, which does not include the harmonised fee amounts from the Rulebook - 77/2025-39, which apply until January 1, 2026, can be viewed on the right in the "Versions of the consolidated text" section.

## 1. Introductory provisions

### Article 1.

This Rulebook establishes the amount and method of payment of fees for the provision of services within the competence of the Regulatory Authority for Electronic Communications and Postal Services (hereinafter: the Regulator), for the procedure or action carried out for the issuance and extension of a license for the use of numbering and an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum, notification of radio stations, conformity assessment, as well as for the technical inspection of radio stations for which an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum has been issued.

The fee referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article shall involve the cost incurred by the Regulator in providing the services referred to in the previous paragraph, which have the character of public services in the sense of the regulations governing the budget system.

## 2. Issuance and extension of a license for the use of numbering

### Article 2.

The fee for issuing the license for the use of numbering shall amount to 27,786.00\* dinars per license.

For the extension of the license for the use of numbering, an amount of 50% of the amount specified in paragraph 1 of this article shall be paid, i.e. 13,893.00\* dinars.

## 3. Issuance and extension of an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum

### Article 3.

The fee for issuing an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum, which is issued based on a request, for a radio station in a specific radiocommunication service shall amount to:

The fee for issuing an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum for a receiving radio station for a simplex radio relay link shall not be charged.

#### **Article 4.**

For a temporary license for the use of radio frequency spectrum, 40% of the amount specified in Article 3 of this Rulebook shall be paid.

For the issuance of a duplicate of an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum, 10% of the amount specified in Article 3 of this Rulebook shall be paid.

For the correction of incorrectly submitted data from the application for the issuance of an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum in that license, made by the applicant, 50% of the amount specified in Article 3 of this Rulebook shall be paid.

In the event of a change in the status of the holder of an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum, or a change in the data on the holder of an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum, relating to a change in name, business name, registered office or identification sign, for an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum issued upon a request submitted to the Regulator in writing, the individual license holder shall pay 50% of the amount referred to in Article 3 of this Rulebook, and for an individual license issued upon a request submitted to the Regulator in electronic form, the individual license holder shall pay 10% of the amount referred to in Article 3 of this Rulebook.

For the renewal of an individual license for the use of radio frequency spectrum, the fee referred to in Article 3 of this Rulebook shall be paid.

#### **Article 5.**

The fee for issuing an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum for radio stations, regardless of the type of radio communication service, used by emergency medical services and other health institutions, anti-hail protection, fire brigades, mountain

rescue services and humanitarian organizations, shall be 138.00\* dinars per radio station, in case of radio frequencies within a radio frequency band that is not allocated for special purposes under the Allocation Plan.

### **Article 6.**

For the purchase of tender documentation in the public bidding procedure for the issuance of an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum, an amount of 0.01% of the minimum (initial) amount of the total fee for the right to use the radio frequency spectrum, referred to in the act prescribing the minimum requirements for the issuance of individual licenses based on the conducted public bidding procedure, shall be paid, and not less than 347,330.00\* dinars.

For the processing of the application of the applicant in the public bidding procedure for the issuance of the individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum, an amount of 34,733.00\* dinars shall be paid.

For participation in the public bidding procedure for the issuance of the individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum based on the conducted public bidding procedure, the amount of 0.03% of the minimum (initial) amount of the total fee for the right to use the radio frequency spectrum, referred to in the act prescribing the minimum requirements for the issuance of individual licenses based on the conducted public bidding procedure, shall be paid, and not less than 1,049,000.00\* dinars.

For the issuance of the individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum based on the conducted public bidding procedure, the amount of 89,205.00\* dinars shall be paid.

### **Article 7.**

The fee for issuing the radio amateur license shall be charged in the amount of the costs for issuing the individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum for a personal or club amateur radio station.

The fee for issuing the CEPT radio amateur license shall be charged in the amount of 1,389.00\* dinars.

The fee for issuing the HAREC certificate shall be charged in the amount of 1,389.00\* dinars.

### **Article 8.**

Fees for notification of radio stations in the appropriate radio frequency band are given in the following table:

1 A radio station within a public mobile and/or fixed electronic communications network is defined by its location, the azimuth of maximum radiation of the transmitting antenna (in the case of a 5G "multibeam" antenna, the physical azimuth is taken), the radio frequency band in which the signal is transmitted/received, the technology used, as well as other parameters.

The fee for changing the technical parameters of a notified radio station within a public mobile and/or fixed electronic communications network, where changing the technical parameters means changing one or more of the following parameters of a notified radio station: antenna azimuth, antenna height, antenna main lobe beamwidth, total antenna tilt, antenna gain, power value, shall be 20% of the amount referred to in Article 8, paragraph 1 of this Rulebook.

The fee for changing the data of a notified radio station within a public mobile and/or fixed electronic communications network, in the case of a change in the business name of the holder of an individual license issued on the basis of a conducted public bidding procedure, at whose request the radio station is notified, shall be 10% of the amount referred to in Article 8, paragraph 1 of this Rulebook.

The fee for notification of a radio station within a public mobile electronic communications network in the case that there are no changes in technical parameters, after the extension of an individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum, issued on the basis of a public bidding procedure, shall be 20% of the amount referred to in Article 8, paragraph 1 of this Rulebook.

The fee for re-notification of a radio station within a public mobile electronic communications network, after the expiration of the period for which an individual license for the use of radio frequencies, or radio frequency spectrum, was issued upon request, in the event that there are no changes in technical parameters, in the period before the expiration of the individual license for the use of the radio frequency spectrum issued on the basis of a public bidding procedure, shall be 10% of the amount referred to in Article 8, paragraph 1 of this Rulebook.

### **Article 9.**

The fee for processing applications for changes to the technical and/or geographical parameters of radio stations in the broadcasting service (radio frequency, location, ERP - Effective Radiated Power, antenna system) shall be charged in the amount of 39,452.00\* dinars.

#### **Article 10.**

The fee for registration in the register of business entities and issuance of the certificate of registration in the register of business entities shall be charged in the amount of 33,064.00\* dinars.

The fee for registration in the register of business entities and issuance of the certificate of registration in the register of business entities, at the request of a business entity that is already registered in the said register and requests additional registration of a service or network, shall be charged in the amount of 50% of the fee for registration in the register of business entities and issuance of the certificate of registration in the register of business entities.

The fee for issuing the certificate of registration in the register of business entities, at the request of a business entity that is already registered in the said register, shall be charged in the amount of 10% of the fee for registration in the register of business entities and issuing the certificate of registration in the register of business entities.

#### **Article 11.**

The fee for investigating interference when the cause of the interference is located within an electronic communications network (mobile networks, satellite networks, fixed networks, networks used for the distribution of media content, which include networks for terrestrial radio and television broadcasting and cable television networks, and energy cable systems in the part used for signal transmission), and is a consequence of the actions, or rather actions or inactions, of the person submitting the interference report, shall be charged in the amount of 80,043.00\* dinars.

#### **Article 12.**

The amount of fee for the radio station technical inspection is given in the following table:

### Article 13.

For issuing the duplicate report on radio station technical inspection, 10% of the amount referred to in Article 12 of this Rulebook shall be paid.

## **4. Conformity assessment**

### **Article 14.**

The amount of fee for conformity assessment and issuing the Certificate of Conformity for radio equipment shall be 20,839.00\* dinars.

The amount of the fee for conformity assessment and issuing the Certificate of Conformity for radio equipment that operates only as a receiver shall be 13,839.00\* dinars.

### **Article 15.**

The fee for issuing the Excerpt from the register of issued certificates of conformity shall amount to 50% of the amount referred to in Article 14 of this Rulebook.

### **Article 16.**

The fee for issuing a duplicate Certificate of Conformity/Excerpt from the register of issued certificates of conformity shall be 2,779.00\* dinars.

### **Article 17.**

In case the applicant withdraws the application during the initiated procedure, or in case the Regulator rejects to issue the Certificate of Conformity, the fee shall amount to 6,946.00\* dinars.

### **Article 18.**

The fee for issuing the new Certificate of Conformity/Excerpt from the register of issued Certificates of Conformity, due to changes in data:

- 1) on the applicant (business name, address, data on the person responsible, etc),
  - 2) on radio equipment that does not affect the conducted conformity assessment procedure (device names, brand, type/model of device, manufacturer's name, etc),
  - 3) in the technical documentation that does not require a new conformity assessment procedure (changes in the Declaration of Conformity and/or technical documentation due to harmonisation with new version(s) of the applied standards, such as do not require a new conformity assessment procedure),
- shall be 2,779.00\* dinars.

### **Article 19.**

The fee for issuing a Certificate of Conformity due to changes made to the same type/model of radio equipment that require the new implementation of the conformity assessment procedure only to the extent of the changes made, shall be 50% of the amount referred to in Article 14 of this Rulebook.

## **5. Final provisions**

### **Article 20.**

On the date of entry into force\* of this Rulebook, the Rulebook on determining fees for the provision of services within the competence of the Regulatory Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services ("Official Gazette of RS", Nos. 34/13, 92/20, 87/21, 112/22 - other regulations and 79/23 - other regulations) shall cease to be valid.

### **Article 21.**

This Rulebook, following the approval of the Ministry of Finance, shall be published in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" and shall enter into force on the eighth day from the date of publication, and shall apply from January 1, 2025.
