



Based on the Arts. 8, paragraph 1, item 1), 23, para. 1 and 59, para 2 of the Law on Electronic Communications ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" No. 44/10) and Arts. 12, para. 1 item 1) and 16, para. 1, item 4) of the Statutes of the Republic Agency for Electronic Communications ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" No. 59/10) and in accordance with the Commission Recommendation of 17 December 2007 on relevant product and service markets within the electronic communications sector susceptible to *ex ante* regulation in accordance with Directive 2002/21/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on a common regulatory framework for electronic communications networks and services C(2007) 5406), 2007/879/EC,

The Managing Board of the Republic Agency for Telecommunications, in its session held on 7 July 2011 passed the following

D E C I S I O N

identifying relevant markets susceptible to *ex ante* regulation

1. The Decision hereby identifies relevant markets susceptible to *ex ante* regulation in the Republic of Serbia and their geographic dimension.
2. Markets susceptible to *ex ante* regulation in the Republic of Serbia shall be the following:
 - 1) Retail access to the public telephone network at a fixed location
 - 2) Wholesale call origination on the public telephone network at a fixed location
 - 3) Wholesale call termination on the public telephone network
 - 4) Wholesale (physical) access to network elements and associated facilities (including shared and full unbundled access to the local loop)
 - 5) Wholesale broadband access
 - 6) Wholesale leased lines
 - 7) Wholesale call termination on the mobile network
 - 8) Retail media contents distribution
 - 9) Retail publicly available telephone service at a fixed location
3. Geographic dimension for markets referred to in item 2. herein shall be the territory of the Republic of Serbia.
4. The Decision shall enter into force on the eighth day following its publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia.
